450 **Set recipe** 4 Chocolate Chip Cookies **Angela Clark Cup** £3 £2 £1

75g(3oz) softened butter
160g(6oz) sugar – caster and/or muscovado
1 medium egg
½ teasp vanilla
150g(5oz) self-raising flour
25g(1oz) cocoa powder
100g(4oz) chocolate chips

Oven 180C/fan 160C/gas mark 4
Cream butter and sugar well.
Beat in egg and vanilla.
Stir in sieved flour and cocoa, and finally chocolate chips, to make a soft dough.
Chill in fridge for 15 minutes.
Make into 24 balls (about the size of a golf ball). Place on lined baking trays, well spaced, and flatten slightly.
Bake for about 15 minutes until firm. Cool on trays for 10 minutes, then transfer to cooling rack. Store in airtight tin.
