There is no age restriction and you can enter individually or as a family.

Please note that it is not a competition as such, but the photos will be uploaded to the Warkworth Show Facebook page, where residents can 'like' the entries. The entry with the most likes will be highlighted.

## CHALLENGE 1 – Deadline Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> June

1. Take a photograph of wildlife in the garden or viewed from your house.
2. Create a bug hotel made from natural materials.

## CHALLENGE 2 – Deadline: Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> June

1. Create a home-made sculpture and photograph it.
2. Draw or paint the view from a window (either from your house or garden shed/summerhouse).

## CHALLENGE 3 – Deadline: Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> July

1. Photograph the most unusual find in your garden/ house.
2. Create a 'selfie' using fruits and or vegetables. (This might be on a dinner plate.)

## CHALLENGE 4 – Deadline: Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> July

1. Who has the most impressive compost heap? Photograph it!
2. Create a pattern made from pebbles.

## CHALLENGE 5 – Deadline: Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> August

1. Photograph your favourite part of the garden or spot on your daily walk.
2. Build a shelter from natural materials (could be for people or animals).
